To *keep nature nearby*, the Land Conservancy of West Michigan (LCWM) permanently protects natural and scenic land. Since 1976, we have protected more than 7,300 acres of West Michigan's forests, fields, wetlands, and dunes. Methods of land protection include:

- **Conservation Easements:** land is protected forever but remains in private ownership.
- **Assistance to Local Communities:** LCWM provides support to county, state, and city governments in their efforts to acquire and protect natural land.
- **Nature Preserves:** LCWM owns and manages 13 nature preserves within our 8-county service area. These natural areas are permanently protected as places where we can hike, enjoy wildlife, and be surrounded by the sights and sounds of nature.
